

The Reality of POPIA and Cybersecurity

The publication of the Regulations to POPIA brings us one step closer to the proclamation of the commencement of the Act. The Regulations are important as they provide guidance to how the parties responsible for the processing of personal information interact with the Information Regulator in dealing with the wide-ranging issues that are within the responsibility of the Regulator.

As the name of the Act suggests, the protection of personal information is heavily dependent on the establishment and maintenance of good information management and information security systems. Without a credible information security management system, processors of personal information cannot expect to achieve compliance with legislation applicable to the processing, management and security of information. In this regard, the Cybercrimes and Cybersecurity Bill currently being considered by the Parliamentary Portfolio Committee for Justice is important and is a critical element of any organisation's plans to manage and protect its information and that of its stakeholders.

In these times of fundamental change, the need for organisations to keep abreast of developments influencing their business and the education of those responsible for governance, management and processing of information is a critical business imperative.
